JA Inspire is more than a Career Exploration Fair, it brings together the business and education community with local middle schools and is designed to help launch these students into their futures: high school, college, and careers beyond. The program consists of three segments: 1) in-class sessions presented by the classroom teacher; 2) the hands-on JA Inspire expo; and 3) an in-class reflection after the career fair.

Session One: Careers and Personality - Students are introduced to the JA Inspire program and take a career interest inventory to discover what jobs suit their interests.

Session Two: Industry Research - Students are introduced to the top industries in the country including Rhode Island's high-growth/high-demand industries.

Session Three: Exploring Careers - Students will explore and research careers that match their personalities.

<u>Session Four:</u> Do You Have the Skills - Students need to know the skills and education requirements to be successful at a job. Students also prepare for the JA Inspire Career Exploration Fair.
